Administrative: \$8,753.99, Service: \$3,378.05

Board minutes report:

- On a request for a donation to the Mushroom Festival the club had budgeted \$100 and will be mailed to that committee.
- Thanks to Diane Closterman, Kiwanis member and employee of Westbrook and Company PC for straightening out our Tax Exempt status with the IRS. Our club would have owed about \$2,000 but will pay a penalty of \$800 to get our tax status back on the straight and narrow. We are a 501 (a) organization.
