Speaker, Jane Bartlett was recognized for her many volunteer efforts in Richmond and Ray County. Jim described Jane as, "a person with an open ear 24/7 for anyone and an open heart to care. She is an Angel in our midst".

Jane and husband Bruce came here from Trenton MO in 1964. Jane is a retired teacher of 30 years. Jane has taught in about all levels of learning. Jane is very active in her church, United Christian Presbyterian Church, a founding member of Gabriella's Garden Board. She is also one of the founders of the "Tuesday Grief Support Group, as well as one of seven members of the Ray County Senior Citizen Board now serving as the Chair of that group. That board has been a very important step in providing dignity and support for our population over sixty years old. A levy of 5 cents per \$100 was passed with the expressed purpose of meeting the needs of our senior citizens. That money is not enough to fill all the needs but it is organized to do the most good for those with the most severe needs.
