The presentation was excellent and I'm listing here the symptoms of ALS:

1. Muscle weakness in one or more of the following: hands, arms, legs or muscles of speech, swallowing or breathing
2. Twitching and cramping of muscles, especially those in the hands and feet.

3. Impairment of the use of the arms and legs.
4. "Thick speech" and difficulty in projecting the voice.
5. In more advanced stages, shortness of breath, difficulty in breathing and swallowing.
