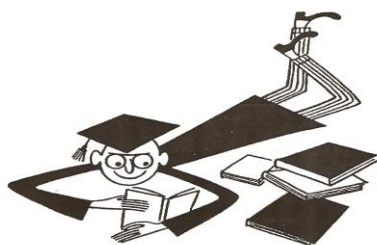
February 7, 2012 Kiwanis: " Changing the world one child and one community at a time." J. McCarter, Secretary
