Marti reminded us that our club donated \$150 to the Eliminate Project a year ago and more money is needed for the 3rd World Countries to protect their children from Tetanus. **Tetanus** is infection of the nervous system with the potentially deadly bacteria Clostridium tetani (C. tetani). Symptoms: **Tetanus** often begins with mild spasms in the jaw muscles (lockjaw). If ignored the disease travels to the chest area causing breathing difficulties. Tetanus has been eliminated here because of our thorough vaccination process starting at birth thru the 8th Grade. "Doc" Cowherd recommends that you should have a shot every ten years. The bacteria are found only on metal objects. Thanks Marti for a very good and meaningful program to help us serve the Children of the World.
