BOARD MEETING FOR MAY 2012

The meeting was called to order by the roll call of President Vickie McGinnis. All stayed for the meeting for additional attendance credit.

The minutes were read by the Secretary and on a motion by Larry Goodloe, second by Brian Bush the minutes were approved as read.

The Treasurer's report was handed out by Treasurer Steve Meyer. Steve went over the report that showed the Service Account with a balance of \$4,361.90, Administrative Account with a balance of \$7,438.47 and closed with a report that showed that the club has a total of \$2,827.36 above last year's totals. Steve also noted that there would be \$2,000 taken out shortly for our scholarship programs.

Other business of today's meeting included the following: The club spent the entire meeting discussing the matter of a Kiwanis Coin celebrating our 90th Anniversary and Secretary Jerry McCarter presented a mock-up of a Kiwanis coin to for the group to discuss. **The Kiwanis Coin promo/info will be in a separate email.**
